

2008 Canadian Vintage Championships **SINGLE-CYLINDER CLASS RULES**

The 5 single-cylinder classes will be as follows:

- Single-Cylinder Fan-Cooled 1974 & Earlier (Bogie Suspension)
- Single-Cylinder Fan-Cooled 1974 & Earlier (Slide Suspension)
- Single-Cylinder Modified Fan-Cooled 1974 & Earlier
- Single-Cylinder Builder's Class
- Single-Cylinder Masters Class 1974 & Earlier

CLASS RULES

Single-Cylinder Fan-Cooled (Bogie Suspension)

-Must be production-line, fan-cooled, single-cylinder model sled offered in 1974 or earlier. No reed valve sleds or slide type carbs allowed. Sled must retain close to stock appearance. No para-rail suspensions. Ski spreaders are allowed, maximum 3". No expansion chambers. NOTE: Bogie suspension may run in all other classes.

Single-Cylinder Fan-Cooled (Slide Suspension)

-Must be production-line, fan-cooled, single-cylinder model sled offered in 1974 or earlier. No reed valve sleds or slide type carbs allowed. Sled must retain close to stock appearance. No para-rail suspensions. Ski spreaders are allowed, maximum 3". No expansion chambers. NOTE: This class is not allowed to enter bogie class, but can enter all others.

Single-Cylinder Fan-Cooled Modified

-Must be production-line, fan-cooled, single-cylinder model sled offered in 1974 or earlier. Leaf spring front end only. Fan must work and have all engine shrouding in place. Sled must retain close to stock appearance.

-Carb: Any factory or aftermarket bore allowed.

-Exhaust: Any aftermarket pipes or expansion chambers allowed.

-Clutches: Stock and aftermarket allowed. Clutch guards must pass safety rules.

-Ignition: Any type.

-Track suspension: Any type is allowed that will fit under the tunnel.

-Track: Must meet current Bonnechere Cup rules no cleated tracks.

NOTE: This class may enter the Builder's Class.

Builder's Class

-Must be a single cylinder, fan cooled or free air 2 stroke engine. No liquid cooled engines. Any type of suspension except IFS. Hood must resemble 1974 or earlier sled. Open to all modifications. This class is intended to promote hand-built sleds. All tech and safety rules apply.

Masters Class

-Use same sleds and rules as the single cylinder fan cooled, bogie and slide suspension classes. Drivers must be 50 years of age or older to compete, and must comply with all safety and tech rules.

***ALL SLEDS MUST HAVE A WORKING TETHER SWITCH.**

***ALL SLEDS MUST HAVE WORKING TAIL LIGHTS.
(1157 BULB WITH BOTH ELEMENTS LIGHTED)**

***ALL SLEDS MUST HAVE WORKING BRAKES.**

***ALL SLEDS MUST HAVE A SAFE CLUTCH GUARD.**

***MAXIMUM 3/8" STUD HEIGHT ABOVE TRACK LUGS.**

***MAXIMUM 5/8" HEIGHT AND 60 DEGREE CARBIDES.**

***CLEATED TRACKS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

***PROTECTIVE VEST MANDATORY. (TEK-VEST OR BEE-WEAR OR SIMILAR) MOTOCROSS VESTS NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

***FULL FACE HELMET MANDATORY.**

***SHIN PADS RECOMMENDED.**

***ALL SLEDS MUST COMPLY WITH ALL BONNECHERE CUP SAFETY AND TECH RULES.**

***ALL RACERS AND CREW MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE FULLY AWARE OF ALL RULES, AND ABIDE BY THEM. ANY DECISION MADE BY AN OFFICIAL IS FINAL.**

***WE ASK THAT ALL SLEDS BE IN GOOD APPEARING CONDITION. THIS IS A PROFESSIONAL EVENT WHICH WE HOPE TO CONTINUE IN THE FUTURE!**

***NO JUNK OR UNSAFE SLEDS WILL BE ALLOWED TO RACE.**
